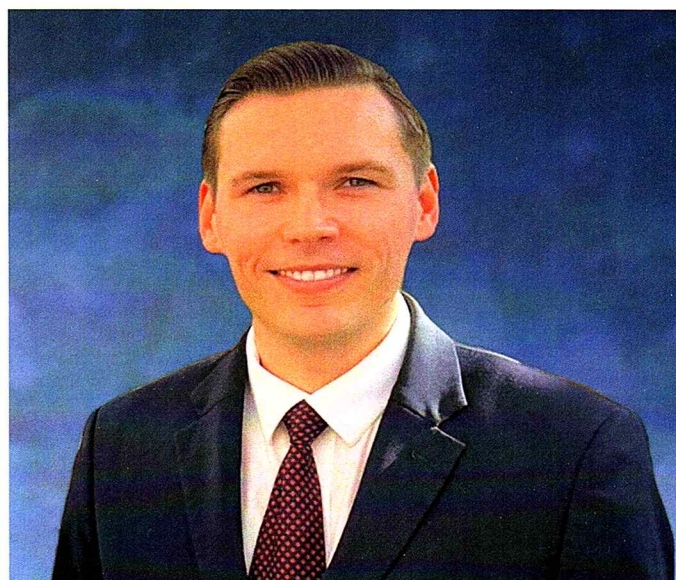

## Disembarkation Checklist

- ☐ Shipboard Account
- Please note the credit card on your account will be charged automatically in the evening of **Sunday, October 19**. Cash accounts and inquiries should be settled the night before you disembark.
- ☐ Your Stateroom
- Check that all drawers and cabinets are empty. Also, please leave the door to your safe open.
- ☐ Luggage
- Use the color-coded luggage tags we have provided to help you locate your luggage on the pier ashore. Clearly fill out the information on these tags.
  - Attach the tags to your luggage and remove any old tags.
  - It is very important that you leave your tagged luggage outside your stateroom on the evening of Sunday, October 19, no later than 10:00 PM**, for delivery in the cruise terminal.
  - Due to logistical reasons, we strongly advise all guests to disembark only with your hand luggage.
  - Keep passports, medications, breakables and valuables** with the belongings you will hand carry.
  - Remember not to pack any items you will need tomorrow morning, such as clothing.
- ☐ Disembarkation Procedures
- You will have received a personal letter explaining disembarkation procedures. Also, you will receive a colored luggage tag depending on your continued travel arrangements. **No announcements will be made.**
  - Please vacate your stateroom by 8:00 AM**, so we have time to prepare it for our next guests.
  - If you have made your own travel arrangements, please proceed directly to the gangway at the time designated in your letter. If you go earlier, your luggage and transportation may not be ready.
  - Please keep the gangway area clear until you are ready to depart. This will help make for a speedy and efficient disembarkation.
  - You will be asked to scan your stateroom key card to security at the gangway as you disembark.
- ☐ Continued Travel Arrangements
- If you have continuing travel arrangements with Viking, please meet at the location and time indicated in your disembarkation letter.
- ☐ Questionnaire
- We value your feedback and suggestions, so please take a moment to complete our questionnaire. You can leave it in your stateroom or drop it in the mailbox opposite Guest Services on Deck 1.

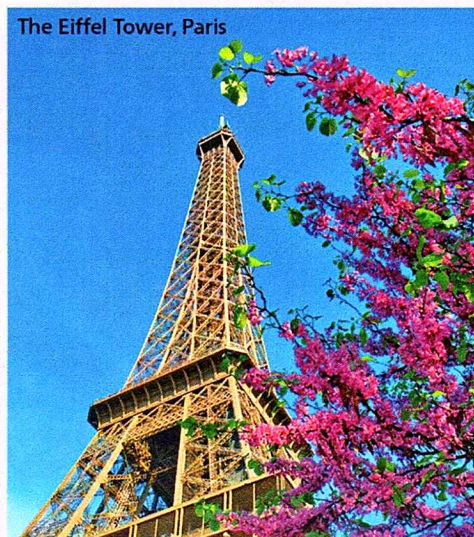
